Registration, Payment, and Cancellation Policy

Registration is due at least 48 hours in advance. Payment must be paid in full and is due at the time of registration, unless prior arrangements have been made with the office. Please call the office at least 24 hours in advance if you need to cancel in order to receive a full refund. If a cancellation is made less than 24 hours before the start of the program, no refunds will be given unless the circumstance is reasonable under the discretion of the Director.

Check-in/Check-out

To assure the safety of all S.E.E.K. participants, your child must be signed in and out by an accompanying adult. Where prompted in the registration form, please provide a list of approved people who can pick up your child. Trees for Tomorrow staff will check the ID of the person picking up your child if s/he is someone other than the person we met at check-in. If someone who is not on this list will be picking up your child, please call the office before 4:00 p.m.

Medication

If your child(ren) has a current prescription for an inhaler and/or Epi-Pen that s/he will be bringing to S.E.E.K., please fill out the attached Medical Release Form and turn in at the time of registration. Please do **NOT** send any other prescription or over-the-counter medications with your child. Our staff has professional training in first aid, anaphylaxis/Epi-Pens, and CPR, but we do **NOT** have the authorization to dispense medications. Thank you for your understanding.

What to Wear/Bring

Participants should be dressed to be outdoors each day. Closed-toed shoes (i.e. hiking or tennis shoes) are required. Please send the following items with your child in a backpack or bag: **lunch, water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray** (optional), **spare clothes/extra layers**, and any **additional items indicated in the program description**.

2017 Program Descriptions

Wednesdays, 8:30am-4:00pm (check-in begins at 8:15am). For youth ages 8-12. Maximum 20 participants (first come, first served). Participants should bring a lunch each day.

June 21 – Team “Trees” – *Discover all that Trees For Tomorrow has to offer! Go on a cross-campus scavenger hunt, build new friendships on our challenge course, and much more. **Bring a 100% cotton t-shirt for leaf printing OR purchase one for \$6.***

June 28 – Wildlife Rangers – *Become a wildlife biologist for the day! We'll explore endangered species, play an animal population simulation game, use radio telemetry to track wildlife, and hunt for animal signs in the forest.*

July 5 – Forestry Frenzy – *Forestry has an important place in Wisconsin's history. Test your lumberjack skills in logging era challenges, become a forester as you learn to identify and measure trees, and uncover the many uses of trees when you make your very own paper.*

July 12 – Nicolet for a Day – *The Nicolet National Forest is an outdoor treasure in the Eagle River area. We'll learn about its history, then become explorers as we visit different hiking trails and lakes within the Nicolet. **Participants will travel off-site in TFT vehicles.***

July 19 – Lake Life – *Lake lovers rejoice! We'll walk to Silver Lake to discover who's wriggling under the water, practice our canoe skills, and learn how we can care for our lakes. **Close-toed water shoes or boots are required OR rent bog boots for \$1 (smaller sizes limited).***

July 26 – Survival Skills – *Back by popular demand! Put your skills to the test as we learn how to navigate with a GPS and compass, build fires and shelters, shoot archery, and much more! How long will you survive?!*

August 2 – Micro-Life – *Sometimes being small is a pretty big deal! We'll get up close and personal with all things itty bitty as we dig in the dirt, explore rotting logs, learn about lichen, and more.*

August 9 – Animal Adaptations – *How do animals survive in their habitats? We'll explore the unique features of different Northwoods animals, go on an animal adaptations hike, and meet some of TFT's live animals.*
