Tribute and Memorial Gifts

Make a gift to Trees For Tomorrow in honor or in memory of a loved one and provide outdoor education experiences for more students. Tribute gifts support our TFT4All Fund, a fund that supports all aspects of programming at Trees For Tomorrow.

General Tribute Gift – Any amount

A donation in any amount may be given in honor of or in memory of your loved one. General tribute funds support our general operating so we can continue to provide quality educational experiences for all program participants. The tribute gift will be recognized in our Annual Report and in our donor database.

Naming Rights (*Canoe*) - \$500 or more

With your one-time contribution of \$500 or more, you may name any one of our twelve canoes in memory or in honor of your loved one. Naming rights are guaranteed for 10 years unless other arrangements have been made. Naming will be honored with two 3" x 8" aluminum signs on the outside of the canoe. Wording will be customized with family input. Plaques will be maintained by Trees For Tomorrow staff for up to 10 years at no cost to the donor. Plaque repair and replacement after 10 years will be at Trees For Tomorrow's discretion. At the end of the naming term, Trees For Tomorrow may offer the opportunity to renew the naming through an additional gift or may choose to retire or relocate the recognition based on campus needs.

Named Scholarship - \$1,000 or more

General Scholarship and Impact Scholarship Gifts may be submitted year-round and will be implemented upon receipt of the tribute funds.

With your one-time contribution of \$1,000 or more, you may create a named scholarship in honor or memory of your loved one to be used for our school programs today. Upon full distribution of scholarship funds, named scholarship will be archived. With your minimum contribution of \$100,000, you may create an Impact Scholarship

Fund in honor or memory of your loved one to be used for current and future programs at Trees For Tomorrow. Impact donation use and restrictions will be mutually agreed upon by donor and Trees For Tomorrow.

Commemorative Picnic Table - \$1,500 or more

Commemorative tables at Trees For Tomorrow are a wonderful way to honor or memorialize friends and loved ones. In addition, some donors may enjoy making a table donation within their own lifetime so they may be able to enjoy the table while on campus and get to see firsthand the value and joy the table brings to students who use it during programming and when local families use it when visiting campus.

Commemorative tables may be installed at the request of donors making a one-time contribution of \$1,500 or more to Trees For Tomorrow. Request for a commemorative table must be made at the time the tribute gift is received by Trees For Tomorrow. Tables may be requested throughout the year. However, installation will occur annually in August unless other arrangements have been made. Table location must be mutually agreed upon by the donor and Trees For Tomorrow. Tables will be personalized with a 5"x8" plaque and message of the donor's choosing.

Tables will be maintained by Trees For Tomorrow staff for up to 5 years at no cost to the donor. Table and plaque repair and replacement after 5 years will be at Trees For Tomorrow's discretion. At the end of the naming term, Trees For Tomorrow may offer the opportunity to renew the naming through an additional gift or may choose to retire or relocate the recognition based on campus needs.

This tribute gift is 100% tax deductible, and the transaction does not constitute the "purchase" of a table by the donor.

Tribute Tree = \$1,500 or more

With your one-time contribution of \$1,500 or more you may plant a tree on campus in honor or in memory of a loved one. A custom 5" x 8" plaque will be placed near the tree using TFT's tribute tree template and a message of the donors choosing. A planting and dedication ceremony may be scheduled June 15-September 15. Tree species must be native to Wisconsin, be selected based on final location, and selected from Trees For Tomorrow's preapproved list of species (contact us for species selection). Final tree species and planting location will be determined by TFT staff.

Trees and plaques will be maintained by Trees For Tomorrow staff for up to 10 years at no cost to the donor. Tree and plaque repair and replacement after 10 years will be at Trees For Tomorrow's discretion.

Naming Rights (~~Raptor Mew~~, ~~Campfire Ring~~, ~~Nature Playscape~~, ~~Challenge Course~~, ~~Archery Range~~, ~~River Overlook~~) - \$2,000 or more

With your one-time contribution of \$2,000 or more, you may name our ~~Raptor Mew~~, Campfire Ring, Archery Range, ~~Low Ropes Challenge Course~~, ~~River Overlook~~, or our ~~Nature Playscape~~ in memory or in honor of your loved one. Naming rights are guaranteed for 10 years unless other arrangements have been made. Naming Rights will be honored with a 24" x 18" plaque at the location. Plaque content may be customized with family input. Plaques will be maintained by Trees For Tomorrow staff for up to 10 years at no cost to the donor. Plaque repair and replacement after 10 years will be at Trees For Tomorrow's discretion. At the end of the naming term, Trees For Tomorrow may offer the opportunity to renew the naming through an additional gift or may choose to retire or relocate the recognition based on campus needs.
